This petition is filed seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 45 dated 13.5.2020, under Sections 307, 324, 506 read with Section 34, 120-B IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Jhander District Amritsar Rural.

On 21.12.2021, following order was passed by this Court:

"Submits inter alia that both the Petitioners were diligent in attending the Court after having been granted bail earlier in the case but could not appear on one date (22nd November, 2021) on account of bona fide mistake of date which was wrongly noted down by their Counsel on the preceding date i.e. 13th October, 2021 in the case.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. R.S. Khaira, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the Respondent/State. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

Adjourned to 30th March, 2022.

In the meantime, the Petitioners are directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned within 7 days from today, in which event, they may be granted interim bail till the next date fixed before this Court."

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners surrendered before the trial Court and were granted interim bail.

Learned State counsel is not in a position to dispute the contention raised.

In view of above, no further directions are called for.

Disposed of.

However, the trial Court would be at liberty to impose such conditions as necessitated to ensure the presence of the petitioners in trial.
