Aggrieved by the summoning of evidence under Section 311 CrPC, the accused had come up before this Court on the grounds that the witness and the medical report was not part of the challan.

I have gone through the impugned order dated 14.09.2022 (P-4), vide which the trial Court observed that the accused had also received injuries and remained hospitalized due to the accident and also given elaborate reasoning for summoning the witness-Dr. Harbir Kaur to prove the medical record.
