[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 03.08.2022, in CRWP No.7335 of 2022 in case titled as 'Jaswinder Kaur and others versus State of Haryana and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CRWP No.7335 of 2022 was disposed of vide order dated 03.08.2022 by directing the respondent to hear the petitioners *qua* the grievance as contained in the representation filed by the petitioners and to take action in respect thereto, in accordance with law within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 25.10.2022, ordering keeping of sharp vigil by increasing patrolling in the area of representationist i.e. village Jatwad, District Ambala by PCR/Rider

in case of requirement of police help. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order dated 25.10.2022, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
