In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that family pension be extended to her in accordance with law in respect of the service rendered by her late husband, who retired from the Police Department.

As per the averments made in the petition, though the family pension was granted but the same was discontinued after May 2014 and that too without giving any reason, hence, the respondents are under an obligation to reconsider the claim of the petitioner for the grant of family pension.

From the pleadings, it transpires that for the relief, which has been sought in the present writ petition, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 25.07.2022 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending

consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/representation, respondent No. 3 is directed to decide the representation dated 25.07.2022 (Annexure P-4) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
