On 10.11.2022, the case was heard at length and the appeal was dismissed, however, the case was adjourned for the counsel for the State to seek instructions as to whether the amount of compensation of ₹50,000/- as was ordered by the learned Single Judge stood paid to the appellant-workman or not.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 14.11.2022, when the case was taken up, the State counsel had informed that the appellant had been paid the amount of ₹50,000/- by deposit in his account on 24.07.2018 as per the judgment dated 25.04.2018 passed by the learned Single Judge.

This fact with regard to the deposit of the amount has been acknowledged by the counsel for the appellant in Court today.

In view of the above, the present appeal stands disposed of.

In the light of of the disposal of the appeal, pending application stands disposed of.
