Inadvertently in order dated 21.11.2022, case number has been written as COCN No.2308 of 2022. The same is ordered to be corrected so as to read as COCN No.2315 of 2022.

[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 03.08.2022, in CWP No.16918 of 2022 in case titled as '**Ashish versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.16918 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in the light of decision dated 21.02.2019 in '**Rahul Kumar versus State of Haryana and another**', CWP No.3841 of 2019, within a fortnight from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that

terms of order (Annexure P-1) but the claim of the petitioner has been rejected, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not wish to pursue the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
