Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent-Commission to issue notices to the candidates selected in final selection list/ final result dated 19.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) after awarding marks under Socio-Economic Criteria for the post of Group D against Advertisement No.04/2018 dated 25.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) for making verification of the eligibility/ Undertaking /Certificates/ Affidavit, including category certificates submitted by the candidates at the time of submission of application.

2. Pleaded case is that petitioners applied for the post of Group 'D' against Advertisement No.04/2018 dated 25.08.2018 (Annexure P-1). Petitioners appeared in the written examination in November 2018. Final result/selection for the post in question was declared on 19.01.2019 (Annexure P-4). Petitioners' names did not figure in the said list. Later on, respondent-Commission also uploaded the details of marks of the candidates who appeared in the written examination. Allegedly, respondent-Commission has finalized the selection for the post in question without verification of the documents, owing to which a number of candidates were selected on the basis of some bogus, fabricated documents and undertakings etc. Vide order dated 30.07.2018 (Annexure P-5A) passed in RA-

CW-462-2017 in CWP-14519-2017, respondent-Commission as well as State Govt. had been specifically directed that scientific verification of each and every candidate (selected candidates) may be done. Still, that was not done in the present case. It is only now that respondent-Commission has started to re-conduct the scrutiny of documents.

Petitioner No.19 through his brother has filed various complaints before respondents No.3 to 5 including before C.M. window (Annexure P-11), but till date no action has been taken by the concerned respondents. Petitioners have also served Justice Demand-cum-Advance Contempt notice dated 03.06.2022 (Annexure P-12) to verify the documents of the candidates selected on the post of Group 'D'.

3. I have heard rival contentions of learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

4. Concededly, no decision has been taken on the demand notice dated 03.06.2022 (Annexure P-12) served by the petitioners till date.

5. In the premise, no grounds for interference are made out.

6. However, petitioners are at liberty to pursue their cause with the Department *qua* which they have already served a notice. It is expected of the competent authority to look into the same to pass appropriate orders.

7. Disposed of.
