The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is petitioner's third attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.55, dated 13.03.2019, registered under Section 20/61 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

As per the case of the prosecution, two boys on being intercepted by the Police party, were found in the conscious possession of 5 kg '*charas*', which falls in the commercial category.

The learned counsel representing the State of Haryana states that the deposition of three prosecution witnesses has already been recorded, whereas, the remaining prosecution witnesses have been summoned for 25.02.2022.

Since, the trial of the case is at an advanced stage, therefore, no ground to grant the concession of bail is made out. However, the learned trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavors for conclusion of the trial

within a period of three months, positively, from today.
