This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.202 dated 28.11.2017, under Sections 302, 450 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

One of the main ground for seeking bail is that the petitioner is in custody since 3.11.2017 and trial is progressing at snail stage.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh submits that out of total twenty-three witnesses, twenty witnesses have been examined. He further submits that earnest efforts would be made to examine the remaining witnesses within three months from the next date fixed.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
