The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to restrain the official respondents from victimizing and harassing the petitioners by lodging fake FIRs at the instance of private respondents over a dispute on the land of the Mandir with a further prayer for issuance of a writ of certiorari directing the revenue officials of the District to revoke/cancel all illegal entries of mutation and other land records in the name of private respondents.

After arguing for some, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to all the alternative remedies available to the petitioners in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
