The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail in a criminal complaint No.212/2017 dated 17.04.2017 under Sections 420, 468, 406, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sarai Khawaja, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order dated 21.12.2021, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has been admitted on interim bail.

The learned counsel for the State as well as respondent No.2 do not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In this view of the above, interim order dated 21.12.2021 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on appearing before the Trial Court as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
