According to the petitioner his title to the land in dispute has been finally decided in his favour by the revenue authorities. Yet, mutation though entered is not being sanctioned despite legal notice dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction may be issued to respondent No.3 to decide the pending legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the pending legal notice dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
