Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.105 dated 05.10.2015 registered under Sections 420 IPC and 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983 at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Roop Nagar.

The earlier one was dismissed vide order dated 20.09.2016 passed in CRM-M No.1023 of 2016 and other connected cases.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the new ground for filing this petition is that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Mr. Navneet Singh, DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State while Mr. Sham Lal Bhalla, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant and acknowledged the factum of compromise.

After hearing the counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the dispute, of which the present petition is an off-shoot, has been settled between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 15 days from today to join the investigation and she shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
