On 10.01.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.365, dated 10.06.2021 registered for offence under Sections 452, 354-A, 376, 511, 506, 120-B of IPC, 1860, Section 25, 29-A of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 10 of POSCO Act, 2012 at Police Station City Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Learned Senior counsel submits that the allegations of raping the prosecutrix are against Hardeep who is in custody. He submits that insofar as the present petitioner, who is 55 years old Government teacher, is concerned, she is alleged to have called the prosecutrix and asked her to marry the main accused, which was declined by the prosecutrix. He submits that the other allegation against the petitioner is that she has been informing the main accused regarding the movements of the prosecutrix. It is his argument that after investigation, the petitioner was found to be innocent and has been summoned by the Trial Court vide order dated 18.11.2021 (Annexure P-5) on an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. He submits that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court and join the proceedings within a period of 10 days from today. In case, she does so and moves a petition seeking grant of bail, she be released on interim bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The trial Court shall also impose any other condition, if deems appropriate.

List on 07.03.2022.”

Upon instructions from Mr. Reetesh Kumar, Advocate, learned senior counsel submits that pursuant to the above reproduced order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

The aforesaid fact has been verified by the State counsel upon instructions from ASI, Sunny.

In view of the above, order dated 10.01.2022 is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of.
