This petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging that inspite of the report dated 01.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) being submitted by the senior Highway Engineer to respondents No.2 and 3-authorities, stating that pedestrian underpass or median cut should be made in the village(s) in question for the purpose of mitigating the grievances of the petitioner, the respondent-authorities are not doing so and the representations/legal notice issued by the petitioner have fallen on deaf-ears.

Learned Additional Solicitor General of India appearing on behalf of all the respondents, on advance copy, submits that the authorities concerned shall look into the grievances of the petitioner and take a decision on the representations/legal notice of the petitioner keeping in mind the report and the opinion of the Senior Highway Engineer (Annexure P-4) expeditiously in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Additional Solicitor General of India, the petition stands disposed of.
