Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondent has not taken up the pending petition filed for completing the entitlement of the petitioners under the Displaced Persons (Compensation & Rehabilitation) Act, 1954 even though the same was filed more than one year and eleven months earlier and five dates have gone by. Thus, it is essential to direct the respondent to take up the matter atleast for preliminary hearing on an early date.
