SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Both the co-petitioners are admittedly major, and, hold the legal capacity to enter into a valid wed-lock.

2. However, the family members of co-petitioner No.1, are not happy with the marriage solemnized with co-respondent No.2. Therefore, co-petitioners apprehend that co-respondents No.4 to 6, may make intrusions into their married life, and, also apprehend that there is every likelihood of theirs meeting threats to them. However, there is no tangible evidence existing on record, about either qua the alleged threats being meted or the threats being potentialized. Therefore, this Court finds no reason to make a mandamus, upon the official respondents, hence to accord them security.

3. Moreover, the learned counsels appearing for the complainant, and, the learned counsel appearing for co-respondent No.7, who is the previous husband of co-respondent No.1, and, who without annulling her marital ties with

him, proceeded to solemnize marriage with co-petitioner No.2, submit(s), that hereafter there would be no interference in the happy married life of co-petitioners. Believing them the asked for mandamus is declined.

4. Be that as it may, even if the previous husband of co-petitioner No.1 is aggrieved from the latter without annulling her previous marriage with him rather solemnizing a second marriage with co-respondent No.2, thereupon he may avail permissible civil remedies under civil law.

5. Disposed of.
