1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1, dated 03.11.2021, in CWP-22407-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 03.11.2021, reveals that CWP-22407-2021, was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 01.09.2021, in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case respondent No.2 came to the conclusion that the petitioner firm was found entitled to the amount claimed, the same be paid forthwith along with interest @ 6% per annum for the delayed payment from the date the amount had become due.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents have released payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement in terms of order Annexure P/1 dated 03.11.2021, in CWP-22407-2021, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant

petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.4, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
