[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.10.2021 in CWP No.20169 of 2021 in case titled as Pankaj Arora vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.20169 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.3 herein to take a final decision on the pending representations within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case conclusion was arrived at that the petitioner was entitled to the amount in question, the same be paid to the petitioner forthwith along with interest @ 6% per annum for the delayed payment from the date the amount became due.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per speaking order, Annexure R/1-T dated 16.12.2021, the petitioner has been found entitled to payment of Rs.1,29,593/- while rejecting the claim

for the amount claimed by the petitioner. Learned counsel states that in the circumstances, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge order, Annexure R/1-T dated 16.12.2021 to the extent the same denies payment as claimed vide representation, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] The same is not opposed to by the learned AAG.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.

[6] Rule discharged.
