1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/2, dated 25.08.2022, in CWP-18834-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/2 reveals that CWP-18834-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to take note of legal notice dated 07.06.2022, served by the petitioner and to pass appropriate orders in respect thereto, in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful has been done in terms of order Annexure P/2 and decision taken on the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 07.06.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
