[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2, dated 29.08.2022 in CWP No.19090 of 2022 in case titled as Nidhi Arora vs. Regional Transport Authority, Ferozepur.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/2 reveals that CWP No.19090 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to finalize the process of approval of regular joint time table in accordance with law on the date fixed.

[3] Learned AAG has produced short reply by way of affidavit of the respondent along with order, Annexure R/1 dated 30.11.2022 as per which regular time table has been framed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner today, who on perusal of the same states that in view of regular time table having been framed, he does not press the instant petition and prays for the same to be disposed of as such.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
