[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 06.09.2022, in CWP No.12693 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.12693 of 2021 was disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to accord the benefit of minimum of the pay-scales as per instructions dated 03.11.2017 w.e.f. the date said instructions were issued with needful to be done within three weeks from 06.09.2022.

[3] Today, learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from *Shri Rajender Bhardwaj, Superintendent (Establishment)*, states that claim of the petitioners has been processed and benefits as per orders as contained in paragraph No.7 of Annexure P-1 would be released to the petitioners within 02 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[4] The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioners and states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition.

[5] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for

the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondents to ensure adherence to the assurance held out by the learned DAG, Haryana, on behalf of the respondents and to release the benefits to the petitioners as per entitlement determined in terms of order (Annexure P-1) within 02 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
