Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in complaint case No.04 dated 14.02.2018 under Section 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 323/506/34 IPC filed before SDJM, Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar.

Even today none has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined the proceedings with the trial Court, in compliance of the order of interim bail dated 06.01.2022 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

A copy of the order dated 11.01.2022, whereby the presence of the petitioners has been marked by the trial Court, is produced and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer has not refuted the fact that the petitioners have joined the proceedings.

He further submits that now the petitioners are not required by

the Police for further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 06.01.2022 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, the petitioners are to abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and they should appear in the trial Court on each and every date of hearing fixed in the trial.
