The lawyers are abstaining from work due to a call for strike given by the Bar.

The prayer in the present petition is that the petitioner be granted concession of regularization w.e.f. 27.01.1999 instead of 08.05.2003 alongwith all consequential benefits and further that the period of service which the petitioner has rendered from 01.01.1993 onwards till the date of regularization be treated as qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits.

From the pleadings, it transpires that the grievance which is being raised in the present petition has already been raised before the authorities concerned through legal notice dated 15.08.2022, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-7, which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time

bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim raised by the petitioner in the present case or in the legal notice dated 15.08.2022 (Annexure P-7), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said legal notice dated 15.08.2022 (Annexure P-7) within a period of eight weeks by passing a speaking order from the receipt of copy of this order. In case, after the passing of the speaking order, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same be released to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
