AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition), who have solemnised marriage against the wishes of their parents.

Representation dated 16.10.2022 was sent through registered post.

Learned State counsel appearing on advance notice on instructions submits that mobile numbers mentioned in the petition are switched off. The contention is that if the petitioners approach the police authorities, needful would be done expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would approach the office of the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of.

There is no doubt that in eventuality of petitioners approaching the police authorities, the needful in accordance with law would be done expeditiously.
