[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/3, dated 17.02.2022 in CWP No. 2973 of 2022 in case titled as Kanwarbir Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/3 reveals that CWP No. 2973 of 2022 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 herein to consider and decide legal notice dated 31.08.2021 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG has filed reply on behalf of respondent No.2 along with orders, Annexure R/1 and R/2 dated 13.06.2022 and 14.11.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners who on perusal of order, Annexure R/1 dated 13.06.2022 states that in view of rejection of claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 31.08.2021, she does not press the

instant petition, but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 13.06.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
