Present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 24.11.2022 passed by this Court by which, the main writ petition was dismissed for non-prosecution.

Notice of the application to the counsel opposite.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection for the grant of prayer as made in the present application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the present application which are duly supported by an affidavit, application is allowed. Order dated 24.11.2022 passed by this Court dismissing the main writ petition for

non-prosecution is recalled and the main writ petition is ordered to be registered to its original number and status and is taken up for hearing today itself.

Learned counsel for the respondents at the very outset submits that though, the petitioner is claiming appointment in pursuance to the advertisement No.4/2015 but, all the posts advertised have already been filled up and the candidates, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the present writ petition are not party to the present writ petition hence, the prayer of the petitioner may kindly be rejected at the outset.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one by impleading all the candidates, who are likely to be affected in case the prayer of the petitioner is allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as the petitioner does not have the details of the candidates, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the present writ petition, the respondents be directed to supply the information of the same so that the petitioner can implead them as party to the present writ petition.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any application is filed by the petitioner seeking details of the selected candidates, the same will be supplied to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the receipt of said request.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view

the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
