This revision petition has been filed challenging the order dated 14.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Executing Court whereby petitioner/judgment debtor's request for extension of time for vacation of the property in question was declined and warrants of possession were issued for delivery of possession of the property to the decree holder-Kirpal Singh.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner may be granted some more time to vacate the property in question, which is his residence for a long time. He also undertakes to hand over the vacant possession of the property in question within a period of four weeks from today.

The prayer is accepted and the petitioner/judgment debtor is granted four weeks' time from today to hand over vacant possession of the property in question on or before 20.11.2022, subject to furnishing of an undertaking before the Executing Court to that effect within a period of three

days from today. In case the undertaking is not furnished and/or the vacant possession is not handed over, this petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms, and the order passed by the Executing Court dated 14.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) shall stand modified to that extent.
