1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.08.2022, in CRWP-7864-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CRWP-7864-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider representation dated 17.06.2022, filed by the petitioners, within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and to take appropriate steps to ensure that no harm was caused to the life and liberty or/and that no hindrance was caused in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

3. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order Annexure R-1/T dated 26.09.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioners as contained in representation dated 17.06.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order dated

26.09.2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 05.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.

5. Rule discharged.
