The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to make payment of medical reimbursement bills to the tune of ₹2,20,469/- of the wife of the petitioner along with interest.

It is submitted by the petitioner that the medical bills submitted to the respondents have not been reimbursed. No reason has been given for not making the payment so far. There has been unnecessary delay in reimbursement of the medical bills of treatment of the petitioner's wife.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pawan Sharda, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has submitted, on instructions from Dr. Andesh Kang, Director, Department of Health and

Family Welfare, Punjab that the respondents are actively considering the case of the petitioner. The necessary reimbursement shall be made to the petitioner within a period of four weeks.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the aforesaid undertaking furnished by the respondents-State.
