The application is allowed as prayed for and HCS (Revised Pay), Rules, 1998 (Annexure P-9), is taken on record.

CWP No.26485 of 2021

The petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the pay scale of Rs. 13500-17250/- w.e.f. 01.01.1996 as per the Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay), Rules, 1998 instead of pay scale of Rs. 12000-16500/- in view of judgment dated 11.03.2019 in CWP-15887-2011 and refix their pay and pension along with all consequential benefits.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage the petitioners would be satisfied if respondent No.2 is directed

to decide the representation dated 20.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) served by the petitioner, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has submitted that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioners.

In view of the above, respondent No.2 is directed to take a conscious decision upon the representation dated 20.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioners are found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
