Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to issue Grade-D Sports Gradation Certificate to the petitioners on the strength of Sports Gradation Certificate issued to him for his participation in 24th Haryana State Games organized by respondent No.4 in the year 2010 from 22.10.2010 to 25.10.2010 held at Faridabad, subject to verification by Haryana Olympic Association.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner be rather granted liberty to move an appropriate representation *qua* his grievance, before the competent authority which may be decided as per law.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the

representation, in case the same is filed by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority/respondents to look into the representation of the petitioner, in case the same is submitted, and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

6. Needful be done within a period of 6 weeks from the date representation is filed.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
