Present writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Kanungo from the date his juniors have been promoted.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 04.03.2021 (P-8) is decided expeditiously.

Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1-District Collector, Sangrur to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice in accordance with law by passing speaking order

within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
