The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 07.10.2022 (Annexure P-20), whereby the petitioner-Mill has not been recommended for allotment of paddy for Kharif Milling Season 2022-23 and order dated 14.10.2022 (Annexure P-22) passed by respondent No.3, whereby the appeal of the petitioner-Mill has been rejected and further to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allot paddy for milling to the petitioner-Mill for Kharif Milling Season 2022-23.

Notice of motion was issued on 21.10.2022 in the said matter.

Since there was a remedy of Clause 24-C of the Punjab Custom Milling Policy for Kharif 2022-23, the Administrative Secretary was directed

to hear the petitioner and treat the matter as second appeal.

Pursuant to the order dated 21.10.2022, learned State counsel would submit that the matter was heard and a decision has been taken by the Administrative Secretary on 28.10.2022, which is now a subject matter of dispute in CWP-25130-2022, titled as *M/s Kuber Rice and General Mills versus State of Punjab and others.*

In this background, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner-Mill does not press the instant writ petition as the same has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
