Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, in case bearing FIR No.104 dated 30.07.2019, registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana, under Section 379 IPC and Section 21 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957, whereby bail of the petitioner has been cancelled and warrant of arrest issued against him.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition. However, he submits that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court within ten days positively and move an appropriate application seeking relief of regular bail there. He further prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the said bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within ten days from today and moves an application for seeking the relief of regular bail there, the same shall be decided within one week thereafter.
