Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.245 dated 20.8.2021 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Mansa, District Mansa (later on offence under Sections 306, 34 IPC deleted and offence under Section 304-B IPC added).

By virtue of the order dated 22.12.2021, the petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail on her appearance before the trial Court.
