SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0074 dated 07.07.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala

Vide order dated 14.01.2022, this Court granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and the operative part of the said order is reproduced hereunder:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature.

Learned counsel for the State fairly conceded that injuries attributed by both the petitioners are indeed simple in nature

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, the petitioners are directed to join investigation and in the event of their arrest by the Arresting Officer, they shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions as enshrined under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.:-

1. *That they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
 2. *That they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
 3. *That they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.*
- List on 25.03.2022.”*

Upon instructions from ASI Swinderjit Singh, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 14.01.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of.
