[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 24.08.2022 in CWP No.15413 of 2020 in case titled as Preet Pal vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.15413 of 2020 was disposed of as infructuous in view of the stand of respondent No.3 while ordering the respondents therein to accord benefit to the petitioner as per recommendation made by the Commission and process the petitioners claim within 30 days in accordance with law.

[3] At the outset, learned AAG has produced copy of appointment letter dated 12.12.2022 issued to the petitioner and states that pursuant to the issuance of appointment letter, the petitioner has joined duty on the post of Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male) (Group – C). Copy of appointment letter dated 12.12.2022 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who states that in view of the petitioner having joined service pursuant to offer of

appointment vide letter dated 12.12.2022, he does not press the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
