ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

The petitioner, apprehending arrest in FIR No.208 dated 24.07.2021, registered under Sections 380, 457IPC (Section 411, 413, 201 IPC added and Section 413 IPC deleted later on) at Police Station Chappar, District Yamuna Nagar, came up before this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail.

2. Vide order dated 22.12.2021, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order dated 22.12.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Copy of the status report by way of affidavit along with Annexures R-1 & R-2, has been filed by the State and the same is taken on record. Based on the said status report, learned State counsel has not opposed the contention made by counsel for the petitioner. However, learned State counsel has opposed the bail and submits that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions.

5. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
6. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 22.12.2021, is hereby made absolute.
