The present petition has been filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 10.11.2021 qua the petitioner only (Sr. No.27) vide which she was posted to 1651 PNR Coy (GREF) situated at Joshi Math in Uttarakhand in Hilly Area; along with certain other prayers.
