Short reply by way of affidavit of Ms. Punamdeep Kaur, IAS, Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala, has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record, subject to just exceptions. A copy of the reply has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the said affidavit, it is stated as under:-

"3. That the office of the deponent has released interest on delayed payment of Gratuity, Leave Encashment and GPF, the detail of which is as under:-
