Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the petitioner has applied for appointment to the post of TGT English in pursuance to the advertisement No.9 of 2015 dated 23.07.2015, and he has not been declared successful.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the result was declared, it has come on record that the petitioner has not been given the marks for experience, which the petitioner was claiming and in case, 12 marks which the petitioner is entitled for keeping in view the experience is granted to the petitioner, the petitioner will become eligible for selection.

Hence, the respondents are under obligation to grant the benefit of experience of 06 years to the petitioner and grant him 12 marks and thereafter, consider the claim of the petitioner for selection and appointment to the post of TGT English.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the

grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-17), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Asstt. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-17) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or opining anything on the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition and raised in the representation dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-17), the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the above-mentioned representation dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-17) by passing a speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
