ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 129 dated 06.11.2021, under Sections 323, 427, 458, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the outcome of a sudden altercation between the neighbours in which simple injuries were caused. It is alleged that the petitioners had beaten up the complainant and his wife. He, however, contends that matter has been compromised and settled through the District Mediation Centre, Moga. A copy of the settlement dated 17.01.2022 is taken on record in CRM-M-54503-2021.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the matter has been compromised, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, the petitioners are directed to appear before the investigating officer within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and on doing so, they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer till submission of report under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.' – for short). The petitioners shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
