Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of order dated 03.01.2019, Annexure P-6, vide which petitioners have been declared as proclaimed person in a private Complaint No. COMI 54/2016/Criminal Case No.3 of 19.02.2016 titled as Ashadeep Kaur versus Sarabjit Singh etc., registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur, Annexure P-1.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the Trial Court and join the proceedings and pay Rs.2.5 lacs to the claimants, who are his wife-complainant and minor son, towards arrears of maintenance. This offer has been accepted by the counsel representing the complainant-respondent.

Keeping in view the above, it is ordered that in case the petitioners surrender before the Trial Court within a period of three weeks from today and hand over a demand draft of Rs.2.5 lacs to the complainant-respondent, they shall be released on bail on their moving an appropriate application in this regard. The Trial Court shall impose any other condition, it deems reasonable, while releasing the petitioners to ensure that they do not commit any default in future. The amount paid will be adjusted against the arrears of maintenance.

Petition is disposed of.
