Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 09.11.2017 passed by the District Revenue Officer-cum-Consolidation Officer, if already not challenged by the petitioner. He states that in case of non-challenge to the said order, the petitioner would move an appropriate application for condonation of delay, which may be considered sympathetically by the authorities keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had earlier filed an application for setting aside of the order dated 21.09.2016. Thereafter he had approached this Court by way of the present writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case such an application is moved by the petitioner, it would be open to the competent Court to take that into consideration and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
