The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.105 dated 26.06.2020 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act added later on) registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 15.02.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 15.02.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 15.02.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
