The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 58 dated 09.06.2019, under Sections 323 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Jhander, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the outcome of a sudden altercation between the parties in which simple injuries were caused.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1-State. He, upon instructions from ASI Harwant Singh, contends that untraced report has been filed by the police which has been accepted in the National Lok Adalat,

Ajnala, on 11.12.2021 and this petition has been rendered infructuous.

Mr. Umesh Aggarwal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2 and filed 'power of attorney', which is taken on record. He contends that untraced report has indeed been accepted.

The petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
