[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 06.01.2021 in CRM-M No.233 of 2021 in case titled as 'Lovejeet Singh versus State of Punjab and others'.

[3] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 06.01.2021 reveals that CRM-M No. 233 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the grievance of the petitioner as projected in representations dated 29.10.2020 and 21.11.2020 and to initiate action on the same, in accordance with law within 08 weeks.

[4] Although, notice has not been issued in the instant petition yet a short reply by way of affidavit of *Shri Harvinder Singh Virk, PPS,*

been filed on behalf of respondent No.1, stating therein that pursuant to decision of representations dated 29.10.2020 and 21.11.2020, FIR has been registered against the accused persons.

[5] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the aforementioned affidavit, no further action is called for and the contempt petition may be disposed of, as such.

[6] In view of decision of representations dated 29.10.2020 and 21.11.2020 and registration of FIR against the accused persons as per claim in the aforementioned representations, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents. Accordingly, the contempt petition is *disposed of*, as such.
