By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.236 dated 01.12.2021, having been registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 323/341/379/34 of the IPC (with Section 379-B of the IPC added later).

Learned State counsel today submits, on instructions ASI Amrik Singh, that the petitioner having joined investigation pursuant to the order of this court dated 22.12.2021, his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the order dated 22.12.2021, made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
