1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 04.02.2019 in CWP-2956-2019.

3. A perusal of order dated 04.02.2019 reveals that CWP-2956-2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 05.10.2018 served by the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, to release the same to the petitioner within three months thereafter.

4. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the filing of the instant petition, the respondents have decided the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 05.10.2018 and have also released payment to the petitioner as per her entitlement, therefore, the petitioner is not

interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. Likewise, learned AAG, Punjab also contends that in view of order dated 04.02.2019 in CWP-2956-2019 having been complied with, the instant petition be disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

6. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel.

7. Admittedly, order dated 04.02.2019 in CWP-2956-2019 has been complied with and payment as per entitlement has been released to the petitioner. Accordingly, in the light of position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
